Jonathan Allen CV



Overview

Jonathan Allen (UK, b. 1966) is a London-based artist, writer and educator whose work has featured in many exhibitions and publications in the UK and internationally since the early 1990s. He is best known for his work addressing the politics of enchantment and various magics at play within late modernity, and for his performance alter ego, the *faux* gospel magician <u>Tommy Angel</u>. Allen has taught widely within UK art schools since the early 1990s, including at the Royal College of Art, the Ruskin School of Drawing & Fine Art and the Architectural Association, as well as contributing regularly to specialist public lecture programs across the world.

As a curator at The Magic Circle Museum in London, Allen has collaborated on projects with many institutions including the British Museum, the Victoria & Albert Museum and the Irish Museum of Modern Art. In 2009 he initiated and co-curated the Hayward Gallery touring exhibition <u>Magic Show</u> that explored the shared imagination between contemporary art practices and theatrical magic. Allen is a regular contributor to the New York-based art and culture quarterly <u>Cabinet</u> for which he guest-edited a theme section dedicated to magic in 2007. His recent book <u>Lost Envoy</u> is published by Strange Attractor Press and distributed by <u>MIT Press</u>.
